Pastor's Column

Greetings Members and Friends of Wesley United Methodist Church,

It's hard to believe it's been a month already! And yet it's hard to believe it's only been a month because we have done so much together! I am so thankful that God has brought me, Hannah, and Haylee to Wesley UMC for this time. We have been welcomed with love every step of the way!

It would be hard to count all of the amazing moments from the past month! Here are just a few of my highlights from the past month...worship, visits in your homes, one on one conversations, small group gatherings, children participating in worship, leading funerals as we celebrated the lives of Wesley members with their friends and families, building a crash test car with my girls, conversations with leaders in the church and community! It has been a busy and blessed first month together.

I also spent 8 days at Holy Wisdom Monastery outside of Madison, Wisconsin with 17 other clergy from various denominations. Our primary purpose together was to fall into the rhythms of the Benedictine lifestyle that make lots of space for silence and contemplation with the hope that we would be renewed for the work that God has in store. While at Holy Wisdom, I sat in contemplative silence, I participated in liturgy of the hours, I walked some of the 140 acres of prairie, I ate two meals a day prepared by an amazing kitchen staff, I read, I slept, I laughed, I cried, and I was renewed. One of the things that stood out for me in those 8 days is that silence and stillness are gifts. And yet, the way that noise and busyness are celebrated in our culture make it hard for us to find spaces to be still and silent. So, I am sharing the message that I heard loud and clear while on my retreat, "stillness and silence are good! Make time for silence! Make time to be still! Time to listen to yourself, God, and others is essential for our wellness!"

May we be still! May we make time to be silent. May we listen for God's still, small voice in the quiet and still moments we create. Amen!

Girl Scout Creator's League

Beginning in September, one of Wesley's former preschool rooms will be the site of a new Girl Scout Creator's League.

The program is open for up to 20 girls in grades 6-12 that will meet twice a month. Participants will be instructed in art history and art techniques, as well as create their own works of arts and crafts in various mediums. The intention of this small group is to provide a place for teenage girls to de-stress from the pressures of being in middle and high school through the therapeutic benefits of creating art. In addition, the group will be going on occasional field trips to experience art at the Art Institute of Chicago and other museums and cultural institutions in the Chicago and the Aurora area. The group will also continue the Girl Scout tradition of doing community service projects through art, such as workshops for younger children, decorations for senior citizen centers, and a Spring Hands-On Art Fair. The group hopes to display their art works at a public showing once a year.

To join, parents will be required to register their daughters as members of Girl Scouts of the USA and pay a \$25 fee so that they are covered by insurance. Financial assistance is available from the Girl Scouts of Northern Illinois to cover this fee and the \$25 group dues to help with the cost of supplies. The group will also be involved in Girl Scouts of Northern Illinois' Fall Product and Cookie Sales to raise funds needed for art supplies and field trips.
