## **REPORTS**

**Trustees:** Douglas flooring was contacted, and they came to fix the carpet squares in the gathering place. The batteries in the women's bathroom faucet need to be replaced. Rick will be contacted. Putting up the Christmas Eve banner was discussed and the banner ordered.

**Staff Parish:** There will not be any Governing Board interviews this year. Please communicate with Pastor Tammy and Kathy Breazeale your intentions for next year.

**Finance:** Pastor Tammy discussed the financial situation to date. Our income is \$302,205.00 and expenses anticipated will be \$314,599.00. We will discuss the shortfall in January and go to the congregation for help. We will present a 50/50 proposition to raise the difference. (50% from the congregation and the remaining amount taken from the Endowment Fund. We are still waiting for the City of Aurora to reimburse us for the cost of the damage done from the clogged city sewers. We still have 15 outstanding pledges to reconcile. We have received pledges of \$190,860.00 to cover our estimated budget of \$243,720.00.

**Pastor Tammy:** Our Church conference is to be rescheduled. The Governing Board will Zoom with our DS Wendy to complete the necessary church obligations (Trustee's reports and Pastor Compensation) before the end of the year.
