Pastor's Column

Greetings Members and Friends of Wesley United Methodist Church,

Change is one thing in life that we can count on especially in The United Methodist Church. In fact, Heraclitus, the pre-Socratic Greek philosopher, said that "Change is the only constant in life", but what he didn't believe or take into account is that God is also a constant in our lives. This is what we are taught in Sunday school and in sermons over and over again. We have personal stories and those of families and friends that confirm for us God's constant present in our lives. We experience God in the greatest moments of joy and celebration, we feel God's comforting presence in our most difficult and challenging moments of life. And when we are feeling distant from God or uncertain, we have scripture to remind us of God's constant presence. One of my favorites is Joshua 1:9, "Have I not commanded you? I had grand plans of becoming a play by play announcer for the Chicago Cubs. I briefly studied radio broadcasting for a year in College, but ultimately received my Bachelor's Degree from The University of Illinois at Chicago in Communications. After a couple of years "wandering in the wilderness" and working as a personal banker (I had been a bank teller during college), I began what has been one of the greatest challenges and yet most rewarding journeys of my life, seminary and the road to becoming a pastor. I earned my Master of Divinity from Garrett-Evangelical Theological Seminary in 2006 and was ordained a Deacon in 2009. I have served churches in Joliet, Chicago, Wilmette, Bolingbrook, Minooka, and Naperville.

I look forward to hearing your stories in the coming weeks and months! Let's meet for coffee, lunch, dinner, or just to chat and get to know more about one another.

As we embark on this new chapter in ministry together, I am certain that God is with each of us. In our excitement and curiosity, in our fear and doubt, in our grief and sadness, and in our shared stories...God's love is constant for you and for me. Now let's go write some new stories!
